1. Minutes approval

- Minutes of the 9 January meeting were approved without changes.

- Prince Turki of the King Faisal Centre in Riyadh will visit SIPRI in late April.

- The Russian language translation of the Yearbook celebrates 25 years this year. An event to honor this will be planned in Russia.

- The Japanese Export Credit Agency (JBIC) has asked for a meeting and possible collaboration with SIPRI.
