### **MINUTES**

#### Participants

#### 1. Minutes approval

- The minutes of the 22 November meeting were approved without changes.

#### 2. Matters arising from the Minutes, not otherwise on the agenda

- Editors are finalizing a concept note template for SIPRI research proposals.

#### 3. Report back

- Several in-house events are taking place in December (Afghanistan, Colombia, DCDC etc). They are all on track.  
- The annual launch of the top 100 arms producing companies is due for 5 December. Planning for this is also on track.  
- The Chinese international relations institute CICIR has expressed an interest in an exchange with SIPRI. This is currently being considered.  
- The Swedish MFA has sent positive signals about additional funding of SIPRI work in the climate and security, mediation and disarmament fields.

#### 4. Staffing and Project Issues

- Stockholm university has asked SIPRI to join a bid for EU funding involving funded internships for PhD students in the nuclear field.  
- The Speaker is confirmed for the 2017 September SIPRI Security Conference, and the Royal Court has indicated interest. The City of Stockholm, the Chamber of Commerce, the MSB agency and others are currently considering offers to participate and provide funding.  
- Issues relating to titles and promotion possibilities within SIPRI will be reviewed after the finalization of the performance assessment process.
