#### **2. Report back**

##### **a. Sweden**

- Sibylle and Wilfred attended the Alva Myrdal Center (AMC) retreat for AMC Working Group Chairs on 21-22 November. The AMC would like to organize a book launch in Geneva for the recently published book, *Alva Myrdal: a Pioneer in Nuclear Disarmament*. SIPRI is interested in supporting the organization of the Geneva launch, and would like to also use the event to highlight that the 1982 peace prize was shared with Alfonso Garcia Robles, a Mexican diplomat.
- A gender-themed brown bag seminar will take place today. Farah will present her upcoming research, which focuses on the interlinkages between gender equality, food security and climate resilience.
- Jannie and Luc will be at the Dutch Embassy on 25 November for a workshop on international law and Ukraine.
- SIPRI will host a workshop on assessing the current and future challenges for the Missile Technology Control Regime on 28-29 November.
