Euro-Center - for information and service

Our service offices, Euro-Centers, are located all around the world and can help you on the spot with information, advice and claims. The personnel speak both the local language and Scandinavian. Always keep your insurance card, with the insurance number, with you at all times during travel. If something happens and you need to contact either the alarm central or Euro-Center you will be asked to state your insurance number.

Make your claim 24/7 at erv.se

If something happens during your business trip, you can make your claim 24/7 at erv.se to get compensation.

*Payment guarantee means that the hospital/doctor bills Europeiska ERV Alarm or Euro-Center directly and you do not have to pay yourself.
