Updates from SMT and Luc

- Some ideas for the Strategic Grant are being tested in view of the new political leadership of the Swedish MFA.
- Dan is going to give a presentation to the new parliamentary Foreign Affairs Committee this month. Ideas and suggestions for this will be gathered from the programme directors.
- A proposal for a partnership with the African Union has been put forward to the AU.
- Explorations to see whether the Gulf dialogue started at the 2022 Forum can be connected to the Tafahum initiative, which also involves CARPO in Berlin, who would like to organize something at SIPRI in March 2023. We are looking into potential activities at SIPRI, potentially together with these partners.
- Munich Security Conference: Timo has been in touch with ZIF in Berlin. They have submitted a proposal for work on EU crisis management and CSDP missions and operations. Yesterday ICG and SIPRI also submitted a proposal for a side event on Sahel region, based on the findings of the independent high-level panel on security and development on the Sahel region.
