- **&frankly action plan update**

Lisa did a presentation about the &frankly action plan on SIPRI level. The prioritized areas are stress, team spirit, diversity and inclusion. Conflicts will be handled on a local (team) level.

Stress: HR will help to facilitate workshops together with line managers to discuss stress factors. Management seminars will also take place to make sure managers are equipped with tools on how to act on stress within their teams. Stress will also be incorporated in the &frankly survey and as an yearly activity in the work environment work.

Team spirit: address the overall team spirit of the institute by more having cross functional meetings, similar to the Code of Conduct workshops. The Work from home guidelines and hybrid working will also be evaluated to measure its impact on team spirit.

DEI: continues work on the recommendations from the DEI group, active measures according to legislation, such as gender salary mapping. The victimization policy will be re-rolled out in staff meetings.

A process for team dialogues was presented. The dialogue format has the purpose to help facilitate discussions about &frankly results, measures to be taken and how create an action plan locally in teams for the identified areas mentioned above.

The presentation was followed by a discussion. It was suggested by the unions to have a plan of how to prevent conflicts on team levels. The plan could be based on the team level discussions and function as ‘best practices’ of conflict prevention.


