Package 1: Basic Data Visualization

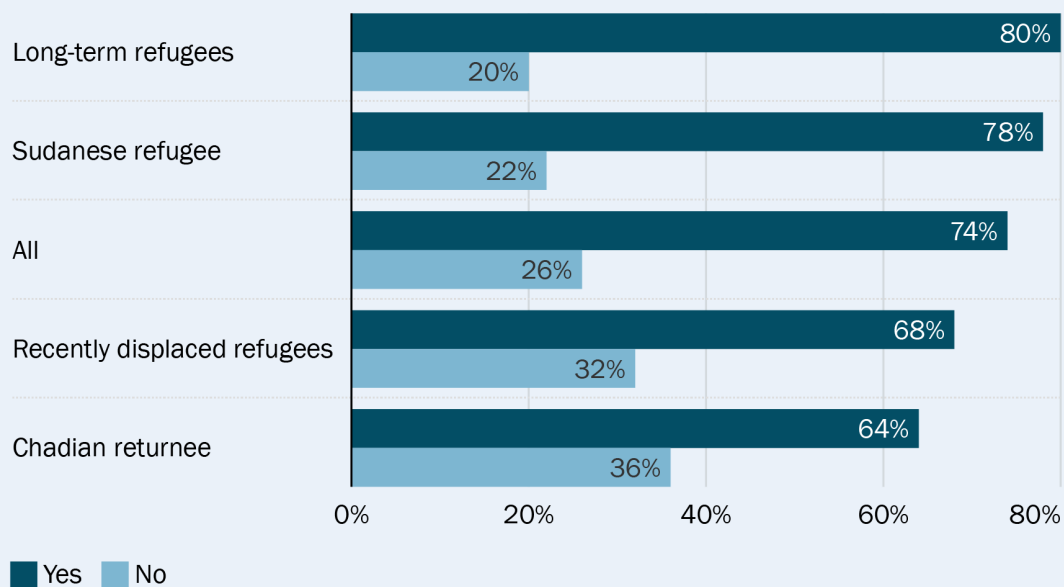
1 working day for 1–4 graphics

Scope: Simple quantitative graphics for quick-turnaround needs.

- **Graphic Types:**
 - Bar charts, column charts, line charts, pie charts based on quantitative data
 - Simple tables and data visualizations
- **Services Included:**
 - Application of SIPRI's visual style guide (colors, fonts, labeling)
 - Formatting for SIPRI publications
 - One round of feedback with the author

Package 2: Enhanced Data Visualization & Infographics

3 working days for 1–3 graphics

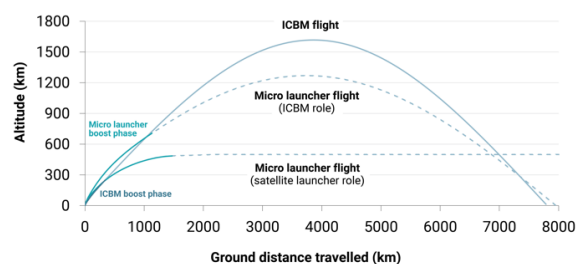
Scope: More detailed and refined graphics with custom layouts.

- **Graphic Types:**
 - Multi-variable charts (e.g., stacked bar charts, scatter plots)
 - Thematic static maps
 - Small infographics (e.g., process diagrams, conceptual visuals)
 - Combination of multiple data-driven elements
- **Services Included:**
 - Application of SIPRI's visual style guide (colors, fonts, labeling)
 - Formatting for SIPRI publications
 - Consultation on the most effective visualization methods
 - Integration with text and research findings
 - Two rounds of feedback with the author

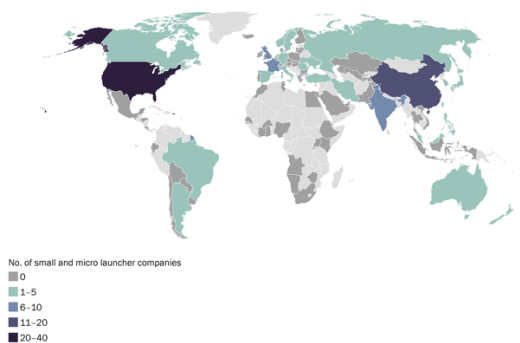
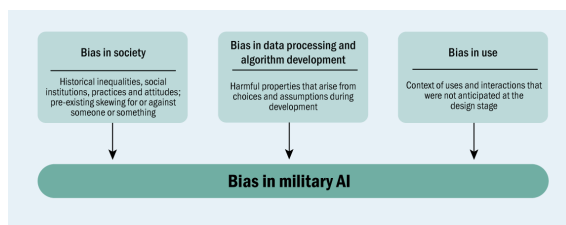

5+ working days for 1–3 graphics

Scope: Advanced, high-impact graphics and interactive elements for in-depth research reports or online features. Interactive online graphics for commentaries after consultation.

- **Graphic Types:**
 - Interactive data visualizations (e.g., dynamic charts, animated graphics)
 - Advanced thematic and geospatial maps
 - Conceptual or non-quantitative infographics
 - Full-page visual storytelling elements for reports/web
- **Services Included:**
 - Application of SIPRI's visual style guide (colors, fonts, labeling)
 - Formatting for SIPRI publications
 - In-depth consultation with researchers to define key visual stories
 - Strategic guidance on which insights to highlight
 - Integration with text and research findings
 - Two rounds of feedback with the authors
