Operations

GAD:

- Congratulations to the Sahel and West Africa programme for securing a new project in Mali, funded by the European Union, for a total of 1.2 million EUR in the next 4 years.
- Compliments also to the Dual-Use and Arms Trade Control programme for securing two projects for a total of about 1 million SEK equivalent, one with the Swiss MFA and the other one with the Voluntary Trust Fund of the Arms Trade Treaty.
- Compliments also to the Director's Office for signing a 100 million KRW (approximately 780 000 SEK) project with the Korean MFA to support them with the World Emerging Security Forum.
- A fundraising coordination meeting will take place on Thursday and the main discussion will focus on the SIPRI list of products.

Finance:
