

## Public Holidays 2026

The following Swedish holidays are days off or have reduced working hours:

- **One additional day off 2026** (since National Day falls on a weekend) – The date may be chosen freely during 2026.
  - Apply in Hailey (Time off → Compensation for National Day 2026)
  - Register in Maconomy (Project name: Absence, number: 3240 Leave of absence w. pay, comp. Nat. Hol. only full day)
- **1 January, New Year's Day** (Nyårsdagen) – Full day off
- **5 January, Epiphany Eve** (Trettondagsafton) – working hours are reduced by **4** hours
- **6 January, Epiphany** (Trettondedag jul) – Full day off
- **2 April, Maundy Thursday** (Skärtorsdag) – working hours are reduced by **2** hours
- **3 April, Good Friday** (Långfredagen) – Full day off
- **6 April, Easter Monday** (Annandag påsk) – Full day off
- **30 April, Walpurgis Night** (Valborgsmässoafton)- working hours are reduced by **2** hours
- **1 May, May Day** (Första maj) – Full day off
- **14 May, Ascension Day** (Kristi himmelsfärdsdag) – Full day off
- **6 June, Swedish National Day** (Nationaldagen) – Full day off
- **19 June, Midsummer's Eve** (Midsommarafton) – Full day off
- **30 October, All Saints' Day** (Alla helgons afton) – working hours are reduced by **4** hours
- **24 December, Christmas Eve** (Julafton) – Full day off

- 25 December, Christmas Day (Juldagen) – Full day off
- 31 December, New Year's Eve (Nyårsafton) – Full day off
